ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE INFORMATION



BY TRAIN

From **Fiumicino Airport** to **Termini Station** (30 minutes)

Leonardo da Vinci (FIUMICINO) airport is about 26 km away. South-west from Rome.

Each 30 minutes (from 5:52 a.m. to 10:52 p.m.) a train leave the airport to reach the central train station (14€ per person).

At Termini you can take the metro (Linea A to «Anagnina» - 1 stop at "Vittorio Emanuele" - 2 minutes) to reach **Rome your home apartment** (1,50€ per person)

From **Ciampino Airport** to **Termini Station**:

Sitbusshuttle: € 6 / Terravision: € 8

BY TAXI

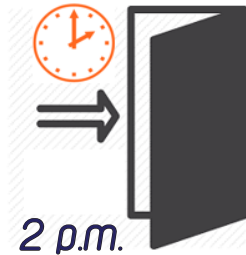
At the airport exit you can find a lot of taxi.

In the ring bell you can read "**TERMINI deluxe**"

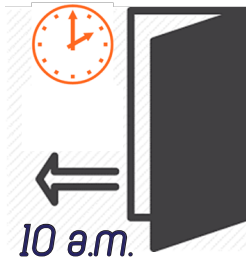
Take the elevator up to the **fourth floor**.

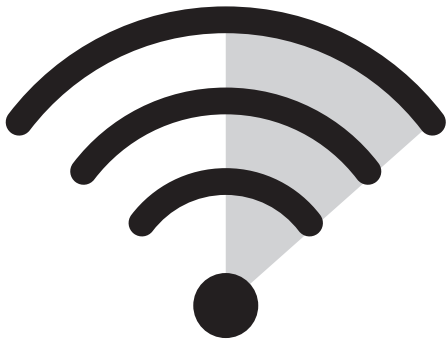


To call a taxi from the apartment, call the number and wait on line until an operator answers, then say:

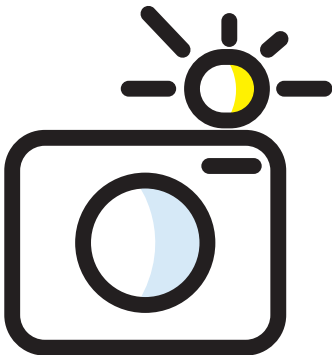

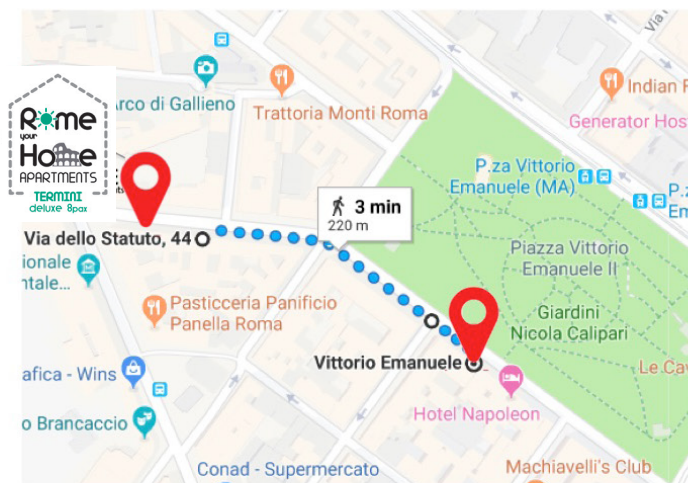


Rome in 2 days:

«Rome in 2days» - First Day (1/8)



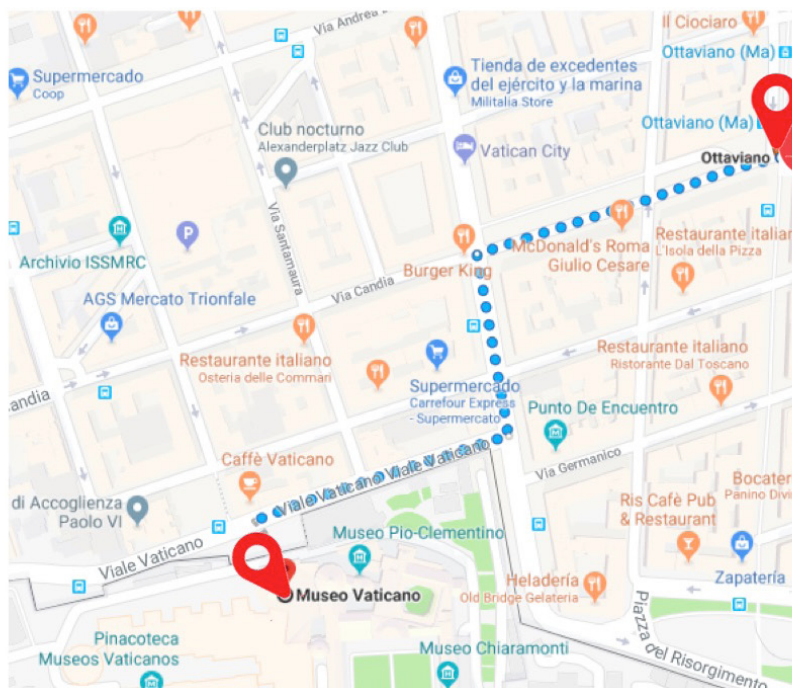
Walk up to «**Piazza Vittorio Emanuele**» metro station
(3 min 220 mt)

N.B. You can get the metro tickets directly at the station at the special machines

*Take the metro towards “**Battistini**” and get off in “**Ottaviano**” (seven stops)*

Walk up to **Musei Vaticani**
(7 min 550 mt)

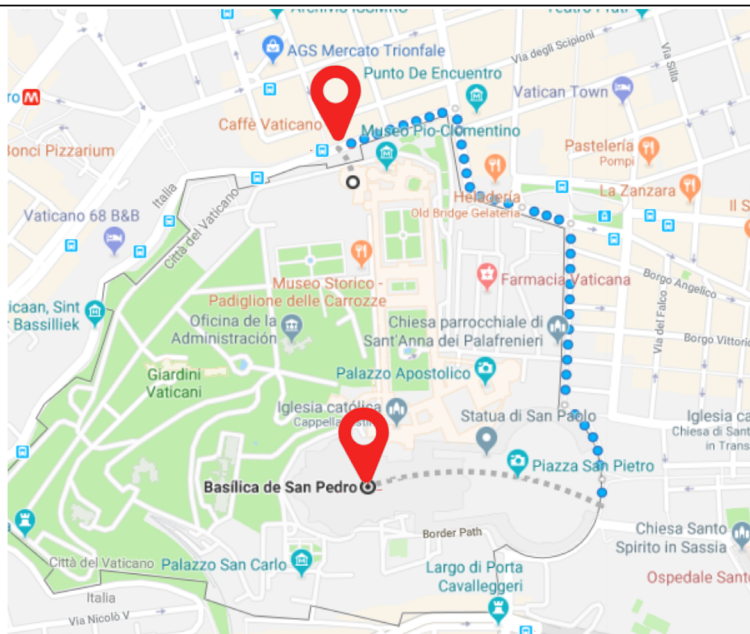
*N.B. from Monday to Saturday 9.00-18.00
(last admission at 4pm and exit from the
rooms half an hour before closing).*

As the museums are really huge, so for a panoramic visit we suggest you to go the Pinacoteca, the Pio-Clementino Museum, the Gallery of the Geographical Maps, the Rooms of Raphael and of course to the amazing Sistine Chapel with its priceless frescoes by Michelangelo.

*Make sure you stay in the museum for at
least two hours.*



«Rome in 2days» - First Day (3/8)



N.B. Remember to wear clothes that are appropriate to the place, otherwise they will not let you in: miniskirts, shorts, and bare shoulders are forbidden.

Walk up to **Piazza San Pietro**
(11 min 1 km)

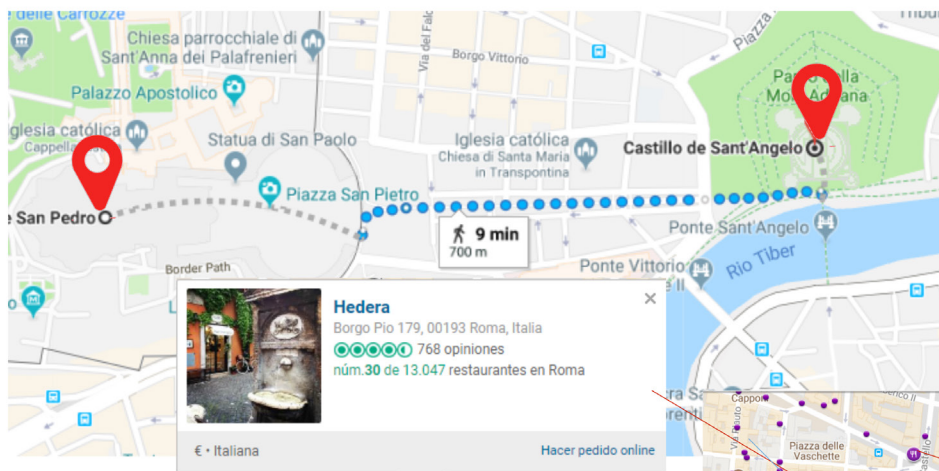
Enjoy the thrill you will experience once you arrive at this one of the largest public spaces in the world and be amazed by the majesty of **St. Peter's Basilica** and the magnificence of the decorations and works of art it contains. Splendid the canopy of Bernini on the papal altar and its huge dome.

Stop to admire the moving **Pietà** by **Michelangelo**, protected by a bulletproof glass, in a chapel at the beginning of the right aisle. Sculpted by the artist at the age of only 25, it's the only work that bears her signature (on the band around Maria's chest).

If you have time enough and you want to climb the **dome**, you can do it by climbing the 551 steps leading up to the top, or taking the lift with leads up to the level of the terrace.



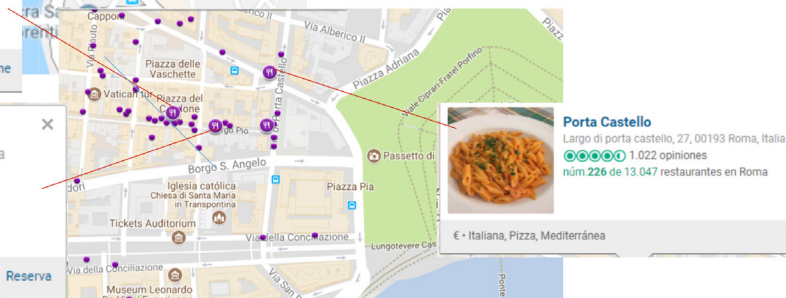
«Rome in 2days» - First Day (4/8)



Walk up to **Castel Sant'Angelo**
(8 min 700mt)

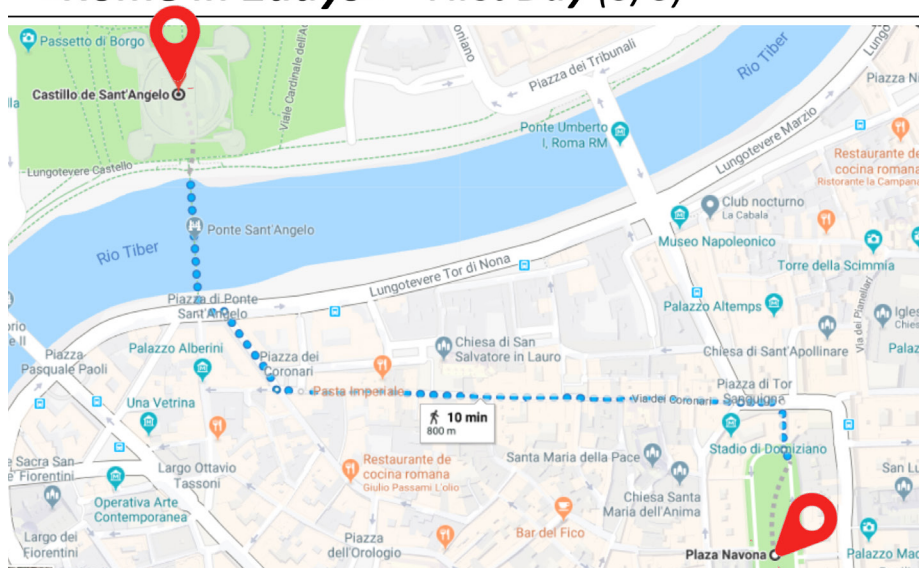
Take Via della Conciliazione all the way to Castel Sant'Angelo for a visit only from the outside. If you are not so tired you can enter and visit it, without neglecting to go to the **Terrazza dell'Angelo**, from where you can enjoy a superb view of the city.

Stop then and **take a lunch break.**





«Rome in 2days» - First Day (5/8)

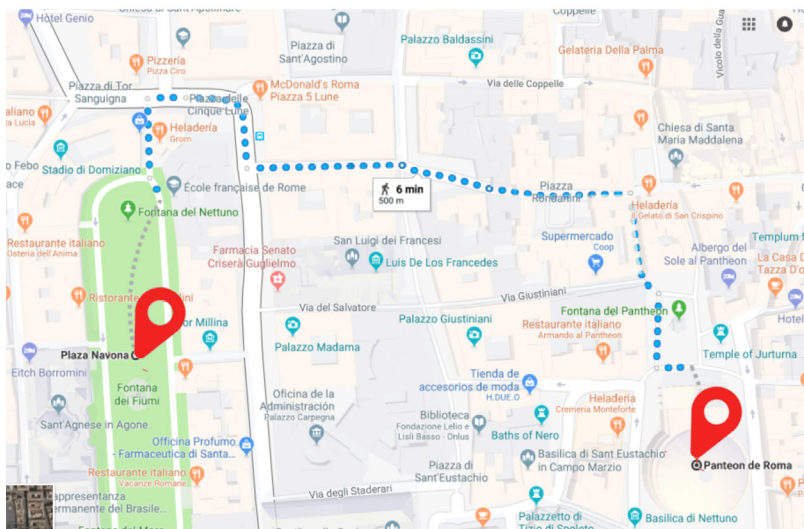


Walk up to **Piazza Navona**
(9 min 800mt)

Piazza Navona will charm you with its beautiful Baroque palaces and magnificent fountains (including the one of the four rivers by Bernini). Get lost in the crowd of tourists, portraitists and street artists who fill it at any time.



«Rome in 2days» - First Day (6/8)

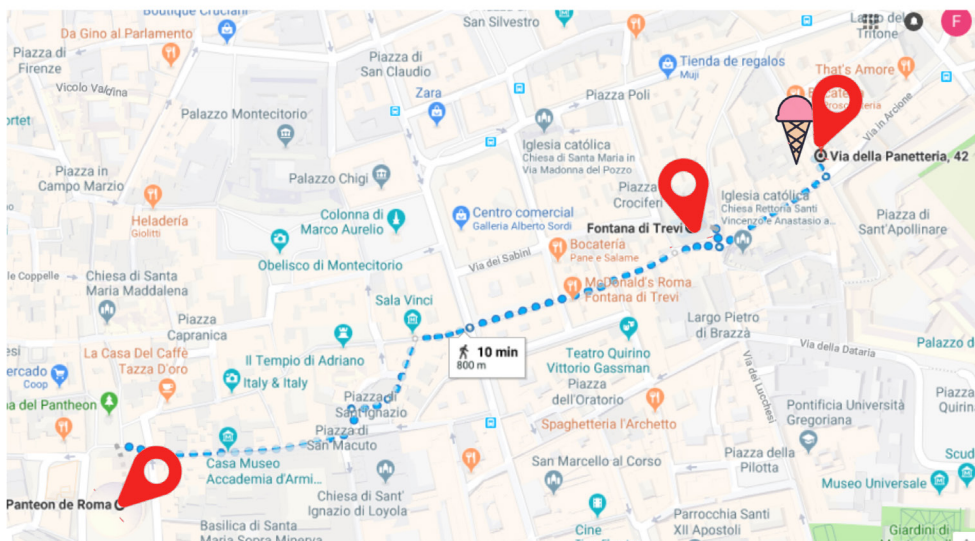


Walk up to **Pantheon**
(6 min 500mt)

One of the many symbols of Rome and the best preserved ancient monument of the capital. Once inside you will be amazed by the magnificent marble interior and the amazing dome, which is the largest dome in the world, built in unarmored concrete.



«Rome in 2days» - First Day (7/8)



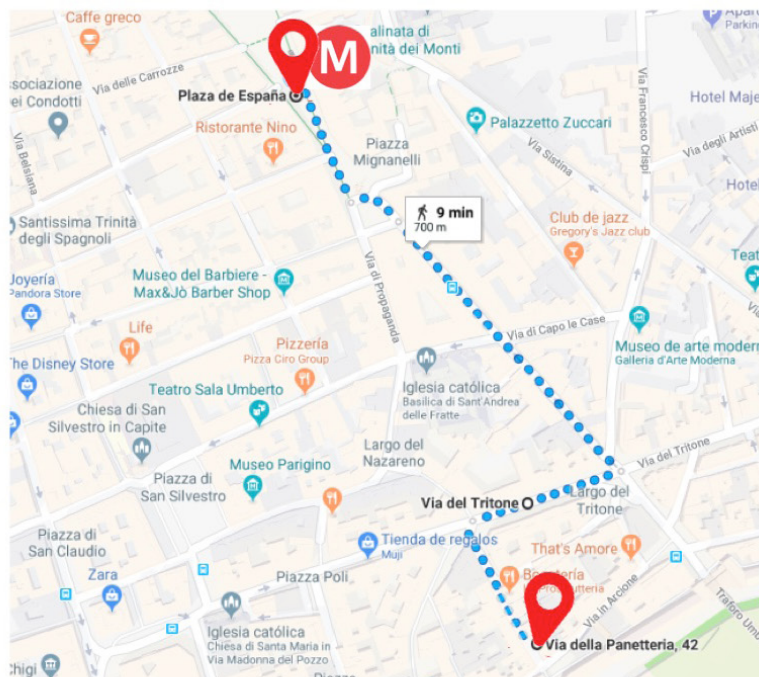
Walk up to **Fontana di Trevi**
(8 min 650mt)

The impact is breathtaking ... you will be literally fascinated by it which is one of the must-see attractions in Rome.

Then you can enjoy one of the most famous ice cream in Rome at the **Gelateria di San Crispino** (Via della Panetteria, 42)



«Rome in 2days» - First Day (8/8)

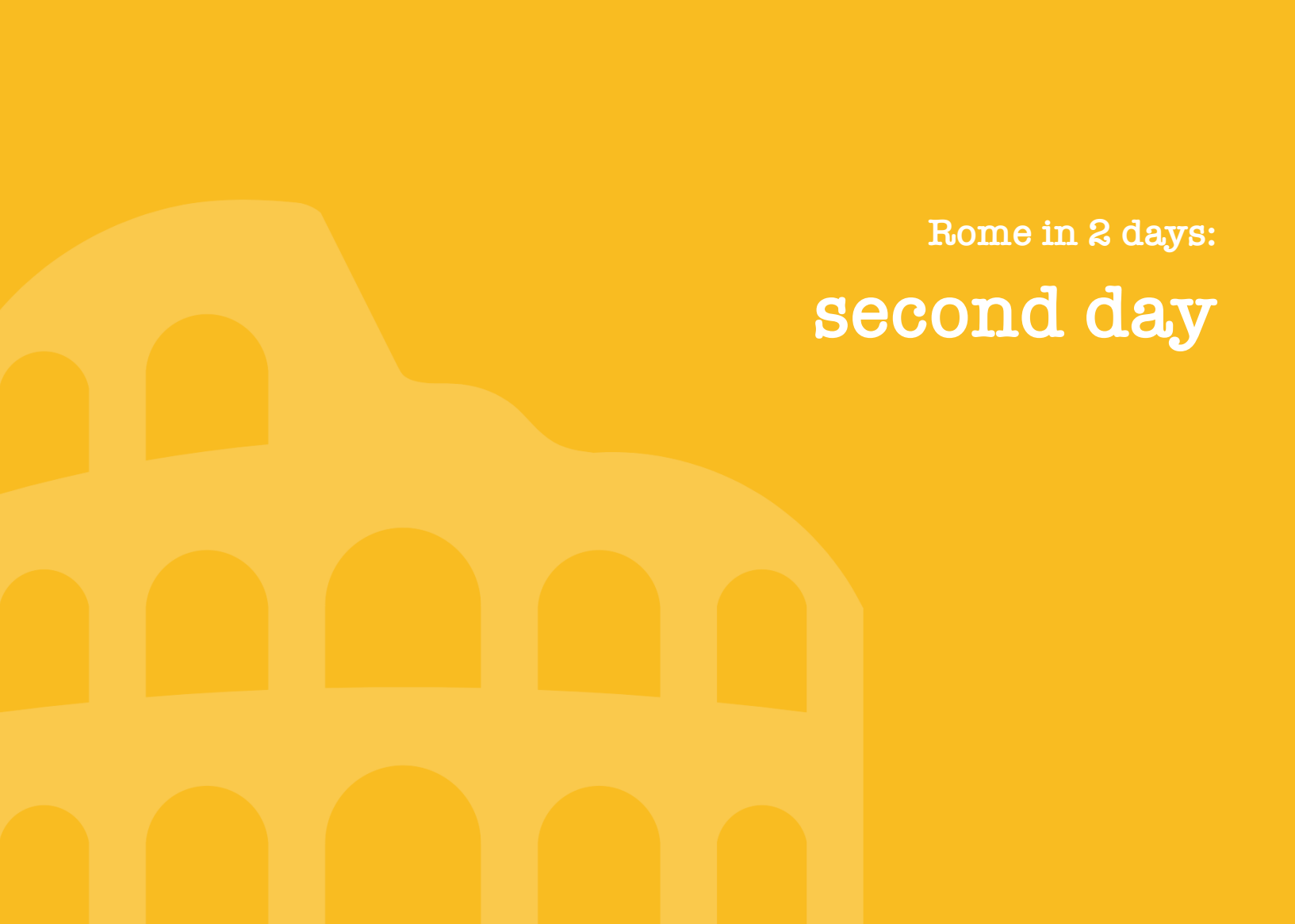


Walk up to **Piazza di Spagna**
(7 min 600mt)

Welcome to the elegant eighteenth-century Piazza di Spagna with its famous staircase of Trinità dei Monti (which with its new restoration has regained its old glory), at whose foot is the famous Barcaccia fountain.

Now you can go back Home

Take the metro at Spagna metro station towards “Anagnina” and get off at “Vittorio Emanuele” (4 stops)

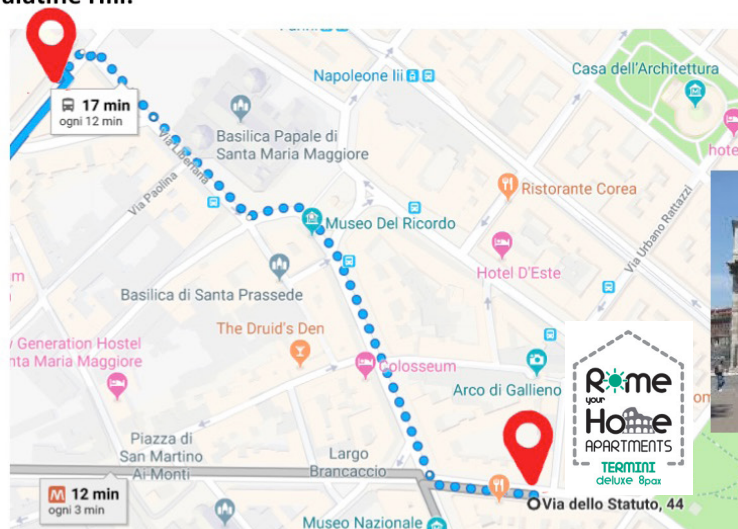

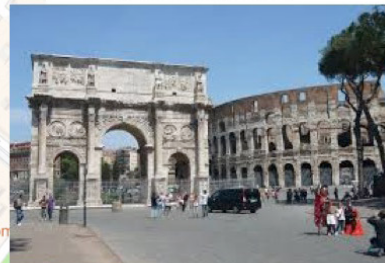
«Rome in 2days» - Second Day (1/2)

Go to **Cavour/Esquilino bus stop** (8 min 600mt) and take the 75 "Poerio Marino" direction (5 stops) ... go down to Colosseo and walk up to Piazza del Colosseo (2 min, 150 mt)

A few steps from the Colosseum, on the right, stands the **Arch of Constantine**, the most famous Roman triumphal arch and the **Palatine Hill**.

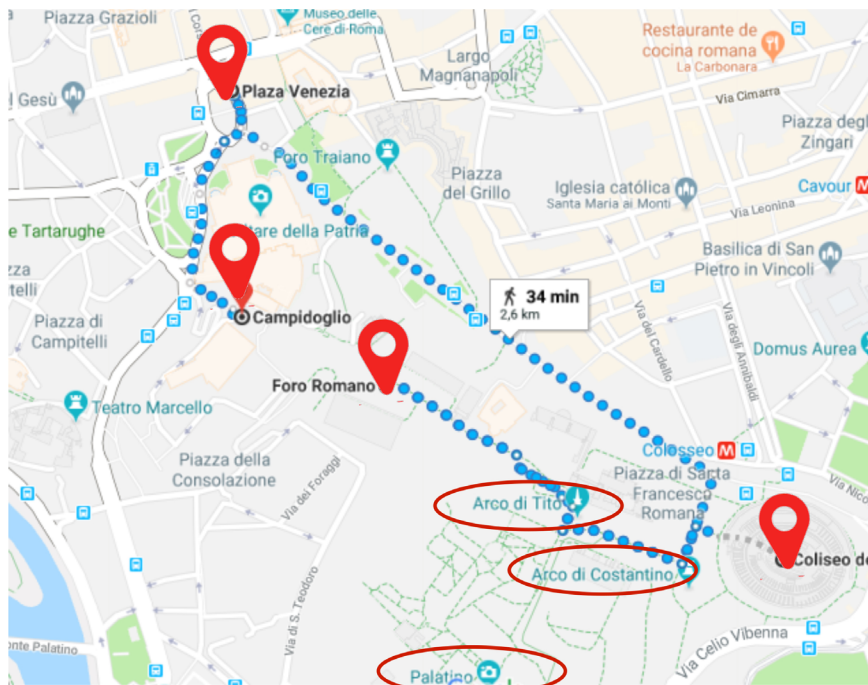

«Rome in 2days» - Second Day (2/2)



Continuing on **Via dei Fori Imperiali** you get to the **Roman Foro**, the ancient square of Rome. On the other side of the road you can appreciate the area of the **Imperial Forums**.

Leave the Fori and head towards **Piazza Venezia**, one side of the square is occupied by a large monument inside where important exhibitions are often hosted: the **Vittoriano**.

The panoramic lifts will take you at to the top where you can enjoy a breathtaking view. The last stage of this is the **Campidoglio**, the smallest, but the most famous Roman hill. The floor of the square is decorated with the famous twelve-pointed star of Michelangelo. At the center of the star, there is a large statue on horseback: it is the perfect copy of the monument to the emperor Marcus Aurelius.

We suggest you to visit the **Capitoline Museums** where the original statue is kept.

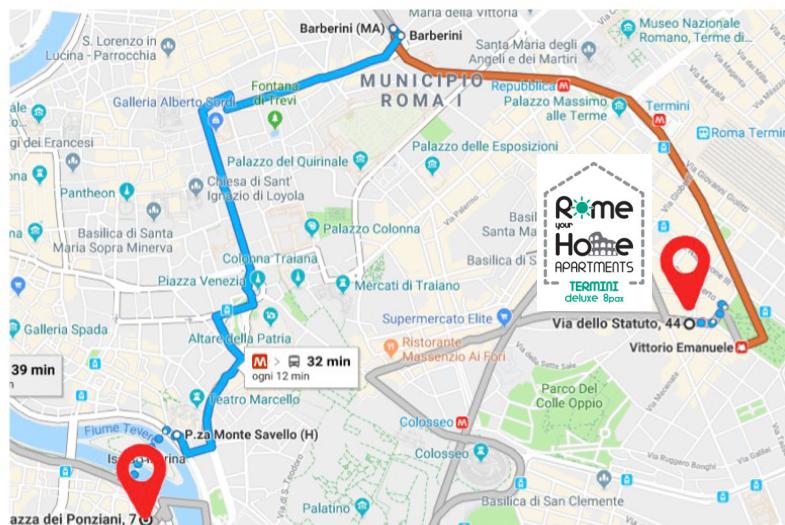




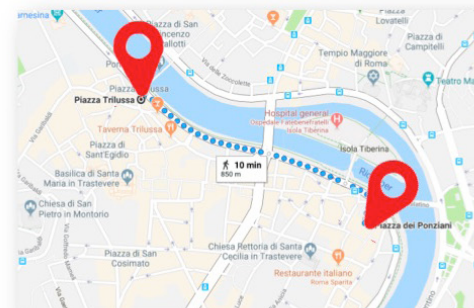
«Rome by night» - First Day - Trastevere

Go to **Cavour/Esquilino bus stop** (8 min 600mt) and take the 75 “Poerio Marino” direction (16 stops) ... go down to Porta Portese and walk up to Piazza dei Ponziani (8 min, 650 mt)

Here you can have dinner at “Trattoria da Teo”, Piazza dei Ponziani 7A telefono +39 065818355



After having dinner take a walk up to the **Piazza Trilussa**. It's a busy area full of people, bars and pubs.



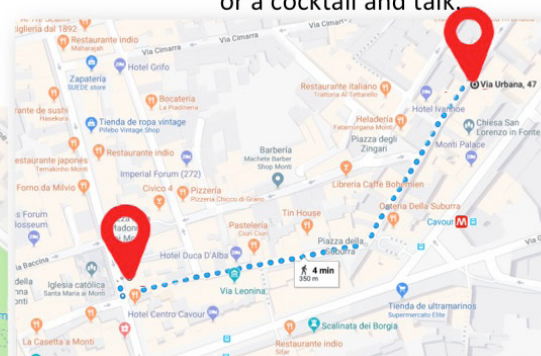
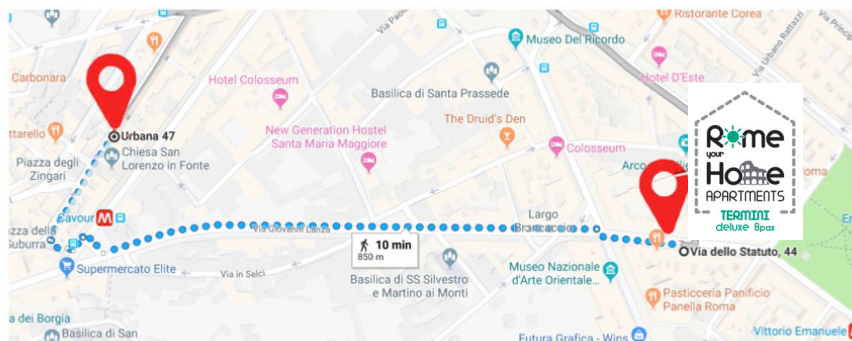


«Rome by night» - Second Day - Monti

Walk up directly to Via Urbana 47 (9 min, 850 mt)

Here you can have dinner at “Urbana 47”, Via Urbana 47 telefono +39 06 4788 4006

After dinner take a walk up to the **Piazzetta Monti**. It's really nice to have a drink or a cocktail and talk.

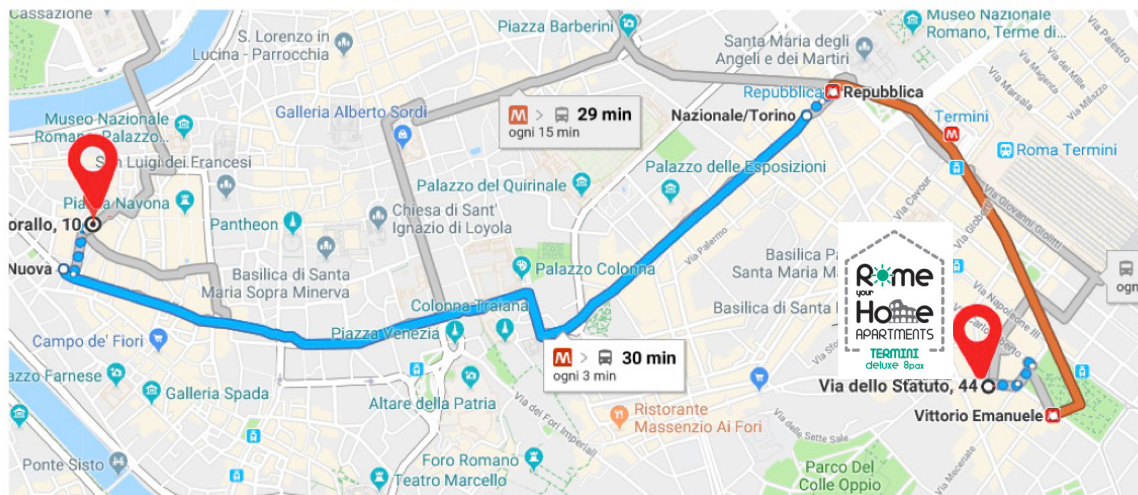
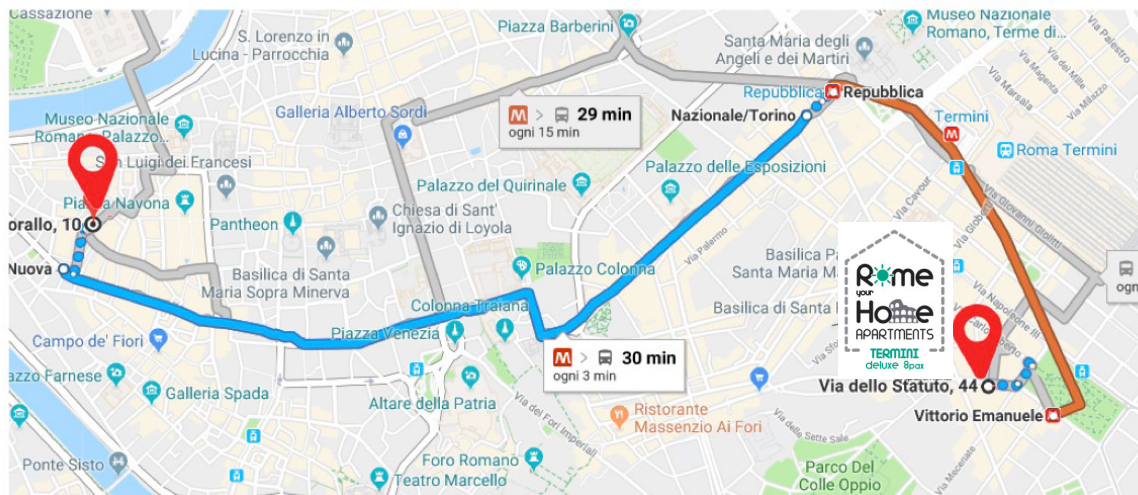




«Rome by night» - third Day – Navona (1/2)

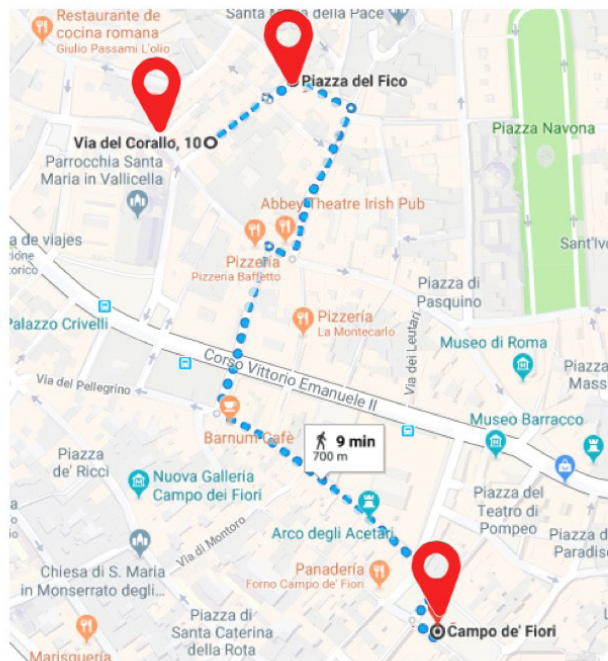
Take the Metro at Piazza Vittorio Metro Station, than get down at «Repubblica» station (2 stops), go to the **Nazionale/Torino bus stop** and take the bus number 40 (4stops) to go down to “Chiesa Nuova” and walk up to Via del Corallo 10 (3 min, 210 mt)

«Rome by night» - third Day – Navona (2/2)



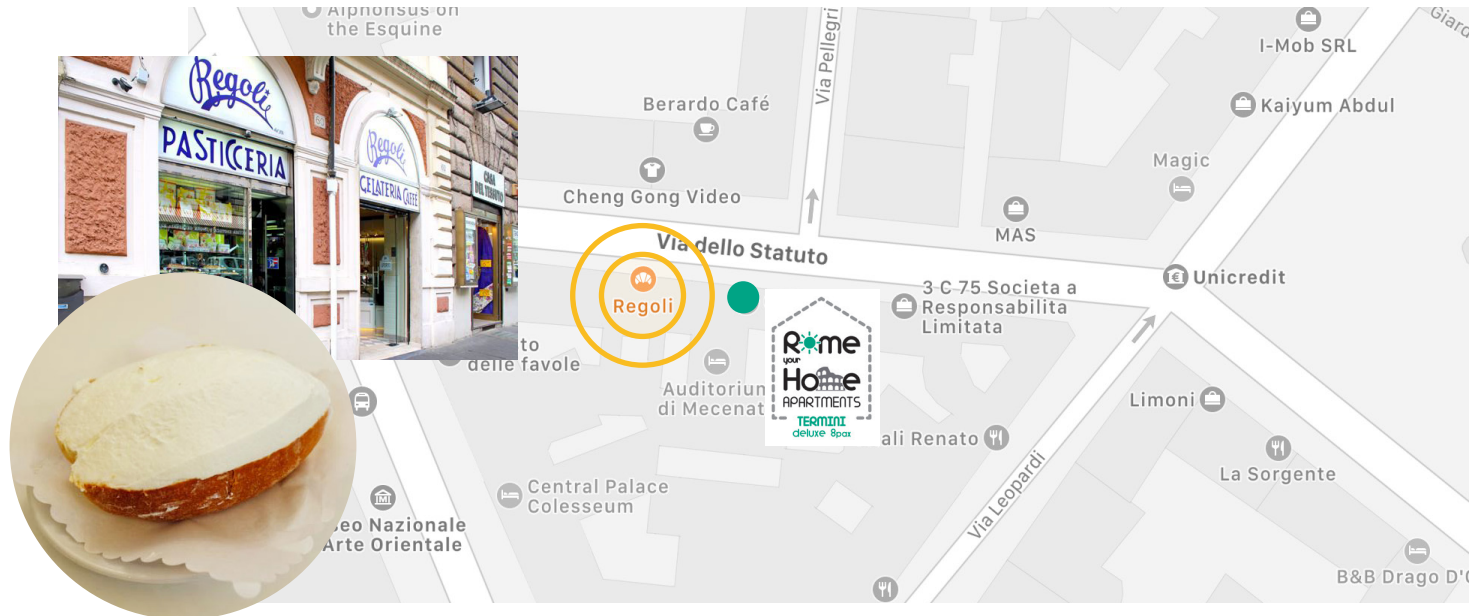
After dinner take a walk up to **Piazza del fico**. This square is very famous in Roman nightlife. There are a lot of people on their feet having a drink and talking.
